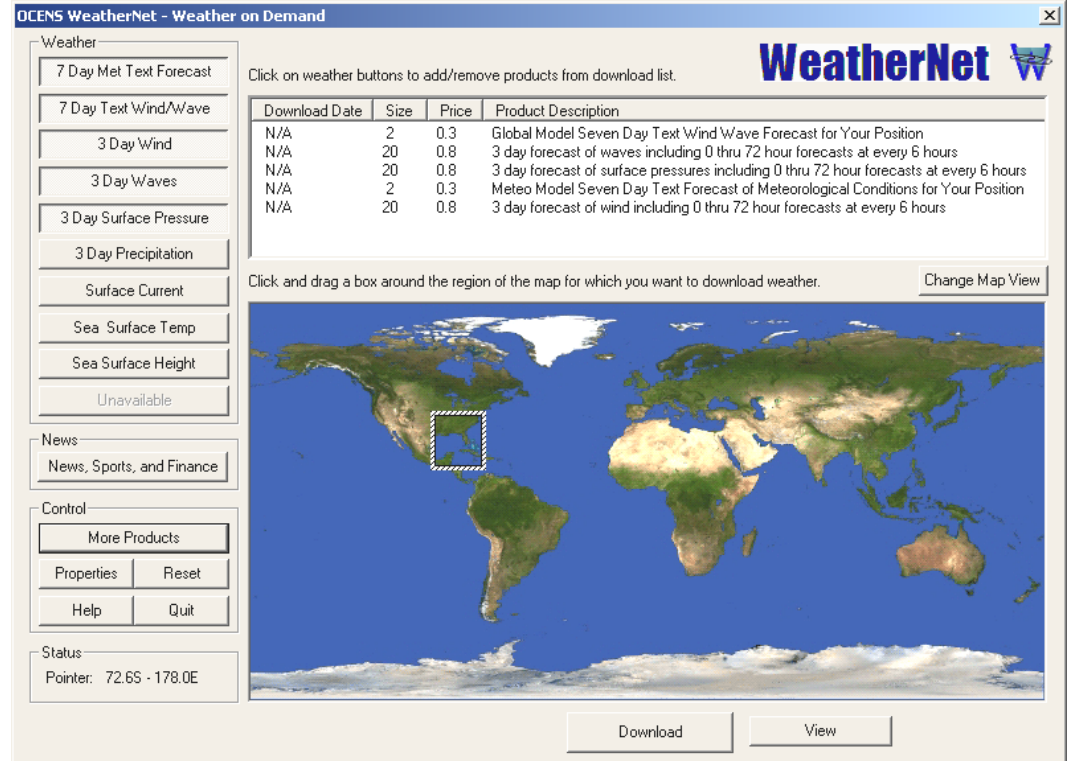


WEATHERNET

Oceans WeatherNet is a system designed to optimize the download of weather and ocean data products via wireless connections. The product offers highly compressed text, images, charts, buoy data, radar, GRIB files, and many more formats. With over 20,000 continuously updated weather products, WeatherNet is the largest most comprehensive source of weather data in the world.

How it works:

There is now a new interface for quick access to some of the most widely used weather and ocean products as well as AP news and sports. Products such as 7 day text forecasts and a variety of GRIB data such as: wind, wave, surface pressure, precipitation. Ocean data such as ocean currents, surface temps, and sea surface heights are also available directly via this view.



Users can easily drag a box around any area of the globe for which they want data and hit the "Download Weather" button.

Once the user hits the download button, WeatherNet immediately connects to the server via a wireless connection or via an email service and downloads the requested data. After the download, WeatherNet can be configured to automatically display the new weather data with programs such as Xaxero's WindPlot.

How does the user pay for the products?

Each weather product is priced independently – from a few cents to \$2 each. This is deducted from prepaid data cards. These are purchased in amounts of \$75, \$250, \$500 or \$1000. Refills are billed to a credit card with a phone call or an e-mail.
